

New PACS Will Create Global Worklist from Disparate RIS/PACS Platforms, Speed Reports, Enable Efficient Reading from Any Location

Access to the global worklist, voice recognition, prior imaging exams and advanced reading tools are available to all radiologists regardless of their location.

The practice also will deploy the Carestream's Vue Motion zero-footprint, Web-based enterprise viewer, which provides convenient on-demand access to imaging studies and patient information on mobile devices as well as PCs and workstations.
