The rechargeable lithium-ion battery provides one hour of continuous use and can be recharged in two hours. The C-MAC® Pocket Monitor offers virtually no learning curve by using standard Macintosh and Miller blades for adults through neonates, and the dBLADE® version intended for patients with exceptionally anterior airways.

Describing his first impression of the C-MAC® Pocket Monitor, EMS World's Mike Smith said, "I couldn't help but notice that the product I was going to see at

the KARL STORZ booth was lying submerged in a bowl of water, where it remained for three days. I think that's pretty remarkable since it is a laryngoscope with a video monitor."
